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Foreword

This Standard Recommendation was prepared following representation from the Private Security Authority to bridge the gap between the technical specifications covering intruder alarm systems (I.S. EN 50131-1 and I.S. CLC/TS 50131-7), access control systems (I.S. EN 50133-1 and I.S. EN 50133-7), CCTV systems (I.S. EN 50132-7) and the non-technical requirements for companies. Both technical and non-technical specifications are needed to underwrite best practice for provision of security services, and can thus be used as a basis for licensing under the Private Security Services Act, 2004.

The agreed draft prepared for public comment was the result of a workshop involving interested parties.

Electronic security services – Intruder alarm, access control and CCTV systems

1 Scope

This Standard Recommendation specifies operational requirements for companies engaged in the installation and maintenance of intruder alarm systems, access control systems and CCTV systems.

It supplements the technical specifications for:

- intruder alarm installations contained in I.S. EN 50131-1 and I.S. CLC/TS 50131-7,
- access control systems contained in I.S. EN 50133-1 and I.S. EN 50133-7 and
- CCTV surveillance systems contained in Annex B (until prEN 50132-1 is published as an Irish Standard, when it will supersede Annex B) and I.S. EN 50132-7.
